Registered Dietitian

Reporting to the Nutrition Program Lead, the Registered Dietitian is responsible for patient dietary support at Calgary West Central Primary Care Network (CWC PCN). As an integral member of the CWC PCN, the Registered Dietitian assesses, plans, implements, evaluates and consults with patients, their partners/spouses and other Allied Health Care workers to ensure that patients receive appropriate and optimal nutritional care to improve nutrition and health status.

Primary Responsibilities:

- Provides 60 minutes consultations with patients.
- Consults directly with Family Physicians and members of the Allied Health Team to provide referring Physicians with concise verbal or written feedback within a timely matter for clinical notes for the patient record.
- Initiates and collects data about the health of each patient for initial screening, in-depth assessment and on-going monitoring and reassessment.
- Identifies priorities, target dates and strategies to contribute to individualized treatment programs.
- Performs strategies and interventions directed by the treatment program, and evaluates the extent to which optimal outcomes have been achieved; recommends alternative treatments as necessary.
- Participates in temporary co-management of patients.

Qualifications:

- Successful completion of a Bachelor of Science Degree program with a major in Nutrition or recognized equivalent. Successful completion of a 40 – 52 week comprehensive post-graduate dietetic internship program accredited by Dietitians of Canada as well as possesses a registration in good standards with the College of Dietitians of Alberta.
- Minimum of two years experience in clinical nutrition.
- Candidate must have sound knowledge of MS applications including Word; Excel; Outlook. Experience with Wolf application would be considered an asset
